Artist's Series - One day on the pitch (2019)

One day on the pitch (2019) Artefacts from craigmoor museum, on dried Grass clippings. Craigmoor oval A special, small parcel of wine from the Oatley family's Chardonnay Park vineyard on the slopes of Mudgee's northern hills. Handpicked and fermented for seven days, with ten days of post-ferment maceration to extract ultimate colour, flavour and tannin, then matured for a year in new fine-grained French oak barriques. Stylish and supple, this distinctive Shiraz is a modern take on the regional style.

Tasting Note

A modern Australian style, textured and finely balanced wine typical of the Mudgee region. Lifted red fruit aromas lead to a flavoursome, palate, with gentle yet firm tannins and a lovely mouthfeel. It will cellar well for 6-8 years.
